She furthered her education in France, obtaining a Bachelor's degree in Management of Cultural Projects in 2006, and in 2009 earned a Master of Arts in European Interdisciplinary Studies in Warsaw, Poland. In Kaliningrad, she worked in the NGO sector, initiating and managing projects at the intersection of art, culture, and tourism. In 2012, she moved to Germany through the German Chancellor Fellowship Program and continued her work in the NGO sector. In 2018, she welcomed the birth of her son. Masha's artistic journey began in 2020 when she studied drawing and painting in various courses in Berlin, followed by studies in graphic design at OfG-Schule. In 2023, she spent time with her family in Belgium and Spain, during where she developed her abstract-figurative artistic style. Since late 2023, based in Berlin, Germany, she explores complex human relationships and diverse artistic mediums in her work.

#### Artist Statement

In my art, I bring human emotions to life through a variety of techniques, including painting, sculpture, and ready-made objects. I strive to create interactive art pieces that offer the public a multidimensional experience, fully immersing them in each theme. Inspired by both personal experiences and universal themes affecting women worldwide, I explore womanhood, expressions of female sexuality, gender dynamics, and the essence of beauty and strength. My work delves into the thoughts and feelings of women navigating various roles in today's society. Through this exploration, I aim to inspire a deeper reflection on what lies beneath the surface of seemingly happy, fulfilled individuals, encouraging viewers to consider the silent struggles and layered complexities that often shape these identities.
